 Basic notions: grammaticalization, pragmaticalization and lexicalization (morphology and syntax; semantic change: metaphor or metonymy?; implicatures and inferences: stages of change). Human nouns (lexical properties: lexical relations and polysemy; research methods: questionnaires and corpus data). Pronominalization and pragmaticalization (indefinite pronouns; impersonal pronouns; personal pronouns; from terms of address to pragmatic markers). Binominals as a locus of grammaticalization (classification and properties of binominals; binominal quantifiers: *sort*, *kind* and *type*-nouns becoming postdeterminers).
